

## **University of Waikato College – Scholarships and Bursaries Terms & Conditions**

**Overview:** This document contains important information about the University of Waikato College Scholarships and Bursaries offered by Navitas NZ Limited (“Navitas”). Navitas offers a limited number of Scholarships/Bursaries to Eligible International Students who confirm their place in one of Navitas’ programmes commencing in July 2026 and/or November 2026 intakes. The scholarships and bursaries are a discretionary contribution by Navitas towards the advertised tuition fee for the eligible programmes stated in Schedule 1,2,3, or their further study.

**Eligibility:** To receive a scholarship and/or bursary, the eligible international student must have accepted an unconditional offer from University of Waikato College (Navitas) to study an eligible programme.

### **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

- There is no guarantee that you will be offered a scholarship or a bursary.
- Scholarships and bursaries are limited and will only be offered to eligible international students once an unconditional offer is made on an eligible programme.
- Scholarships and bursary amounts may vary depending on the source country of the eligible international student.
- All scholarship and bursary amounts will be applied in New Zealand Dollars (NZD).
- The University of Waikato College Scholarship and/or Bursary will be credited against your tuition fee for your programme.
- The Scholarship and/or bursary will not be refunded to you, should you withdraw your acceptance of an offer.
- Navitas reserves the right to decline a scholarship or a bursary for any student at their discretion.

### **July and November 2026 intake Scholarship and Bursary Scheme:**

#### **Schedule 1 University of Waikato College International NZD\$4,000.00 Scholarship**

- This Scholarship is available to full fee-paying international students who are citizens of the following countries: China, India, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Pakistan, Bhutan, Maldives, Vietnam, Cambodia.
- This Scholarship applies to students enrolled in a Foundation or Diploma programme, excluding students enrolled in the Certificate of Attainment in Foundation Studies Accelerated
- This Scholarship provides a NZD\$4,000 credit against the student’s tuition fee for the first programme
- Students are not required to apply for this Scholarship; it will be automatically offered to them after they have met the eligibility criteria.

### **Schedule 2 University of Waikato College International NZD\$3,000.00 Scholarship**

- This Scholarship is available to all full fee-paying international students, excluding students from regions named in Schedule 1 who are eligible for the University of Waikato College International NZD\$4,000 Scholarship.
- This Scholarship applies to students enrolled in a Foundation or Diploma programme, excluding students enrolled in the Certificate of Attainment in Foundation Studies Accelerated.
- This Scholarship provides a NZD\$3,000.00 credit against the student's tuition fee for your programme.
- Students are not required to apply for this Scholarship; it will be automatically offered to them after they have met the eligibility criteria.

### **Schedule 3 University of Waikato College Academic English Bursary**

- This Bursary is available to all full fee-paying international students enrolling in a qualifying English language programme.
- This Bursary applies to students enrolled in the Certificate of Attainment in English Language (with academic endorsement)(CAEL), as part of a pathway offer leading to an eligible University of Waikato College Foundation or Diploma programme (i.e. CAEL packaged with a Foundation or Diploma programme).
- This Bursary covers up to 2 levels of CAEL, equivalent to a maximum of 20 weeks of study.
- This Bursary provides a 10% tuition fee discount, applied as credit against the student's tuition fee.
- Students are not required to apply for this Bursary; it will be automatically offered to them after they have met the eligibility criteria.
